Class Schedule:

Every Wednesday from 5:30-6:45 p.m. (See Schedule for dates with no class.)

Expectations:

1. *Attendance is required for every Wednesday class session.* If a student is unable to be in class, please let Pastor Ruesch know in advance. The student is accountable for any missed memorywork, quizzes, or workbook assignments.
2. *Attendance is required at the Divine Service every Sunday.* Part of preparing to be a member of the church is being present to receive God's gifts. The student shows that s/he treasures God's gifts by being there to hear His Word in church. Each Sunday, students will complete a "Worship Study" sheet and return it following the service.
3. *Completion of all memorywork assignments is required.* Every student is expected to come to class **on-time**, ready to recite the assigned memorywork. Parents are expected to work on memorywork with the student throughout the week. If there are difficulties with memorizing the assignment, please speak with Pastor Ruesch about other options.
4. *Students will participate as acolytes during worship services.* A schedule will be distributed for serving as acolytes. Students may switch dates with each other in case of schedule conflicts. There will be an acolyte assigned for every Sunday service. Students should arrive a half-hour before the service on the first Sunday scheduled and 15 minutes before the service after that.

Pastor Ruesch will schedule a visit with each family in January 2022 to talk about the student's progress and readiness for confirmation *or* advancement to year two.

Parents are not required to attend class with their child, but are welcome to do so.
